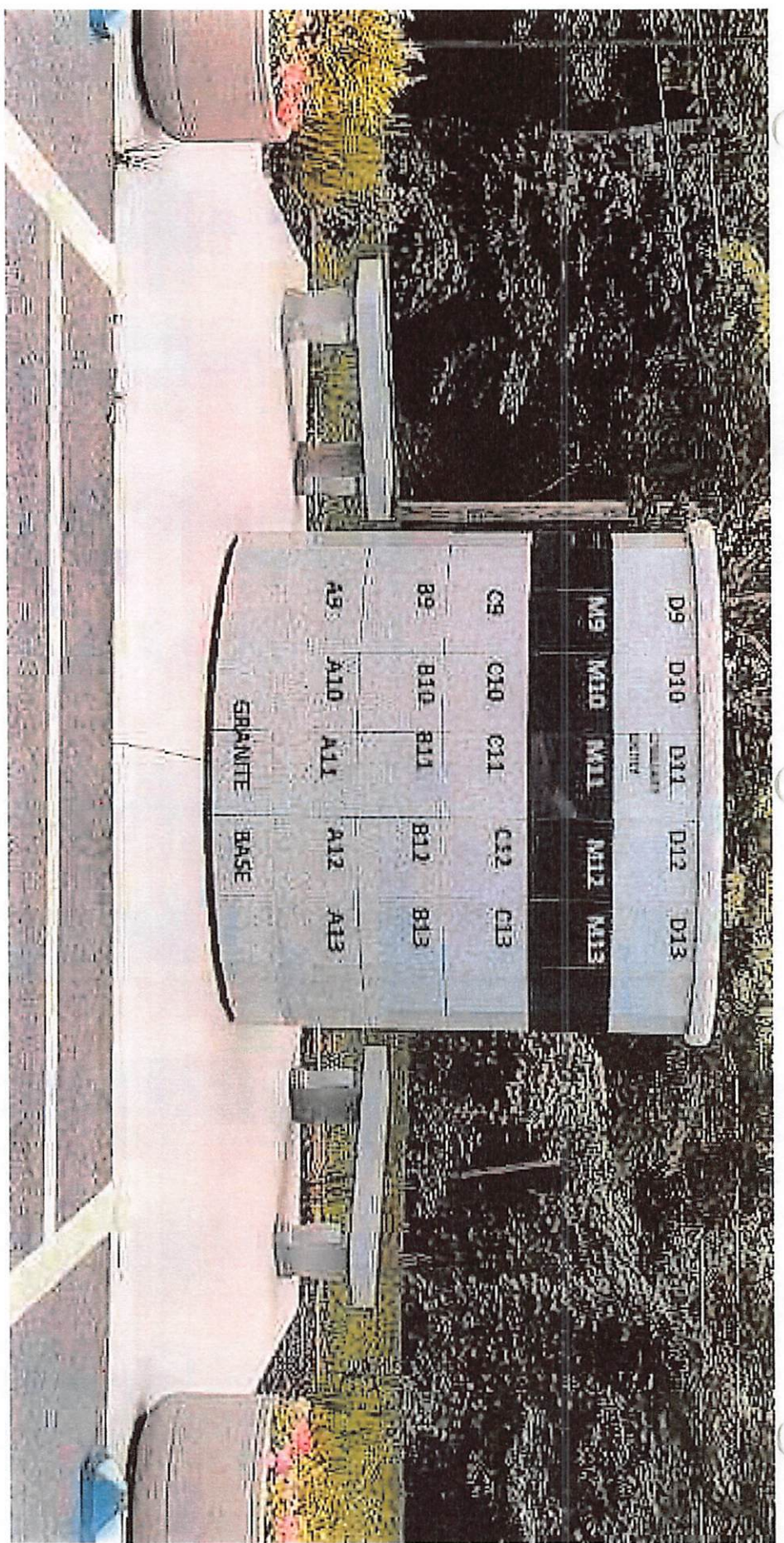

Columbarium/Ossuarium in Memorial Park

Columbarium Space

Attached is information on the Columbarium/Ossuarium in Memorial Park.

A Columbarium is described as a structure for storage of funerary urns, holding cremated remains. There are 100 total companion "niches" that are sold individually and are capable of housing one or two sets of remains.

There are five levels of "niches," A-D and M. The prices vary for each level. Niches prices are listed below and include the open/close costs, limited inscription services, up to two openings of the niche (additional openings \$100), Weekend/Holiday/After hour openings are an additional \$100.

Ossuary \$450 (Center space)

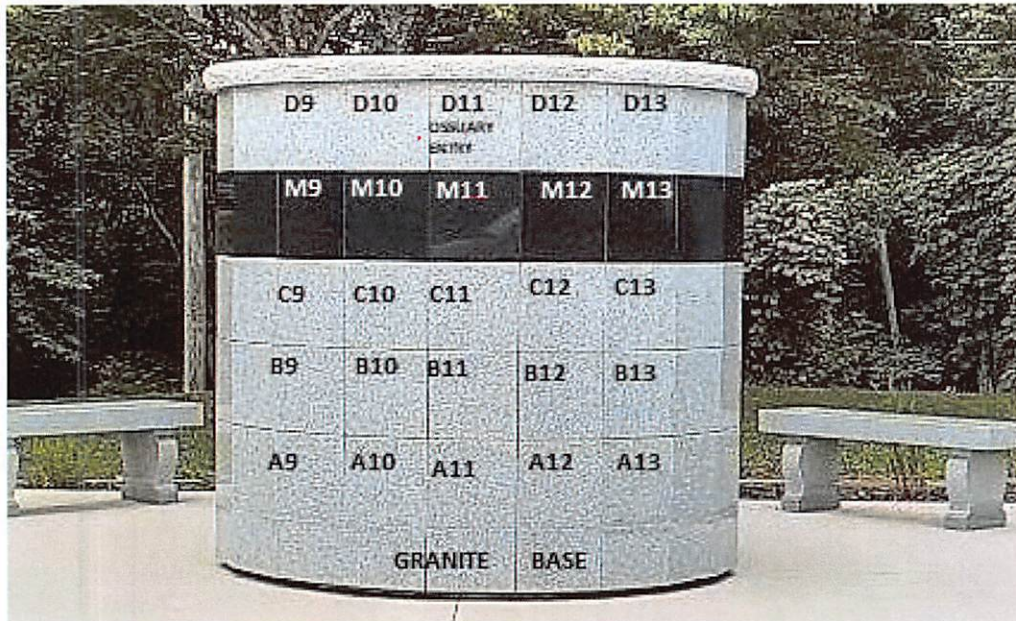
Row D \$1800 (Top level)

Row M \$2000 (Black band around middle)

Row C \$1700

Row B \$1600

Row A \$1500 (Ground level)



Purchasing Ossuary space

The Ossuary Space is an affordable option when one does not desire to purchase a niche. Soft Urns (Satin bag containing cremains) are deposited into the center core of the Columbarium, where they rest in the shared ossuary vault. The ossuary space has a capacity to house 225 soft urns.

- \$450 fee includes open/close with the exception holidays, weekends or after normal business hours. An additional \$100 will be charged for that exception.
- Purchaser will need to buy a velvet cremains bag from a vendor or funeral home, must adhere to the size requirements for the columbarium.
- Open/Close date and time will need to be scheduled with Public Works. By law, a licensed funeral director does not have to be present to commit the cremains unless the family has made arrangements for a service with a funeral home.
- Inscription services are limited to one name (First Middle Last) in the font that was agreed upon between the City and Engraving company.
- In the instance that multiple cremains are to be inurned to the space (In one bag/Urn) the purchaser will pay the \$450 amount as well as any extra inscription charges that are incurred for additional names on the memorialization door.
- Proper documentation will be filed with the Clerk of Lumpkin County apart from the PT-61 form.
- If multiple cremains are co-mingled (in one bag/Urn) each individual will be named on the certificate of inurnment to be recorded the Lumpkin County Clerk's Office.

Example:

Husband and wife cremains have been joined together. They wish to inurn them in the Ossuary space. The purchaser of the ossuary area is paying for one space. Cremains need to be transferred to a satin bag (preferably done by a local funeral home to ensure size is compatible with entry point of ossuary).

Extra inscription fees will apply for multiple names.

- The family may choose to inurn the cremains themselves into the Ossuary space **OR** have public works assist with the inurnment process.
- If the family chooses to inurn the cremains, Public Works will remove the niche door and open the ossuary space entrance for the family. Once the cremains are inurned Public Works will close the ossuary entrance and secure the niche door.
- If funerary services are preformed through a funeral home, then the funeral director will perform those duties.

The engraving company will remove the memorialization door (D1 or D11 also access door for ossuary inurnment) and replace the door with a temporary marker. He will return the door once the inscription is complete.

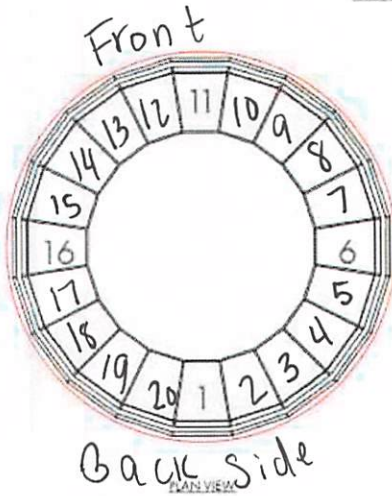
The internal space fee includes the open/close fee as well as an Ossuary memorialization inscription on door D1/D11. Satin bag and urn are both avail for purchase through City Hall or privately through funeral homes or online vendors. Please note that City Hall/Public works personnel are not responsible for transferring cremains to Satin Bags. We recommend utilizing a local funeral home to assist with the transfer. The soft urn can be no larger than the entry point of the ossuary space.
